TOWN OF HALIFAX ORDINANCE

OVERNIGHT PARKING ON TOWN STREETS

SECTION I: NO OVERNIGHT PARKING FOR NONPASSENGER VEHICLES.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person, company, corporation or other entity to leave any vehicle, other than one used primarily as a family car, on the town streets of Halifax overnight.
- B. Overnight shall be defined as the period between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- C. This ordinance is to insure the safety of persons traveling the narrow streets of the Town of Halifax.

SECTION II: PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

- A. A violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and any person convicted of such violation shall be punishable as provided in North Carolina General Statute 14-4. Each days violation of this ordinance shall be a separate offense.
- B. In addition, enforcement of this ordinance may be by appropriate equitable remedy, injunction or order of abatement issuing from a court of competent jurisdiction pursuant to G.S. 153A-123(d) and (e).

SECTION III: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption.
